# **Charlotte Wildlife Stewards Scholarship**

Charlotte Wildlife Stewards (CWS) is offering one \$1000 Conservation Leadership grant to a Mecklenburg County student per year.

Candidates for the Conservation Leadership grant must be enrolled full time and attending an accredited North Carolina college or university. Graduate and undergraduate students who are majoring in the areas of wildlife, fisheries, forestry, conservation or the environment are eligible, and may be enrolled in either 2-year or 4-year programs.

A good record of scholarship and extra-curricular involvement has an impact on final decisions. Need and socio-economic elements are considered.

Applications must be received via electronic transmittal no later than 5:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time (EST) on June 30, 2023. Applications that do not include electronic copies of unofficial transcripts and other required documentation as detailed below, will not be considered.

Grantees will be awarded their scholarship no later than August 1, 2023.
